The benefits are a little exercise a couple of days spent outdoors and a chance to win a free TMA for the season among a small group of other trustees also the satisfaction of riding your section of trail and seeing how your section measures up to the others.**

The secretary records the minutes of the meeting every month that's it and the vice president has to fill in to help run a monthly meeting in the event the club president cannot also the vice president does have to chair a committee.
